

## Discipline vs. Punishment

## Punishment is:

- 1. Adult oriented.
- 2. Requires judgment.
- 3. Imposes power from outside.
- 4. Invites more conflict.
- 5. Focuses on "restricting" the child.
- 6. Concentrates on child "paying" for mistake.
- 7. Focuses on external control.
- 8. Expresses frustration.

## Discipline:

- 1. Shows children what they have done wrong.
- 2. Gives them ownership of the problem.
- 3. Gives them ways to solve the problem.
- 4. Leaves their dignity intact.
- 5. Uses logical and realistic consequences.
- 6. Teaches the benefit of making good decisions.
- 7. Teaches a life lesson.
- 8. Focuses on developing internal control.
- 9. Redirects children toward success.
- 10. Role-models good parenting skills.

Give a hungry child a fish a day and the child will be fed for that day; teach the child how to fish and the child will be able to feed himself/herself for a lifetime.
